GROUP TOUR INFORMATION

HOURS OF OPERATION

Tuesday through Friday 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Saturdays: 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.

The average visit is 1.5 hours. The Gaylord Pickens Museum, home of the Oklahoma Hall of Fame is closed on Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Eve, Christmas Day and New Year's Day.

ADMISSION

For groups of 15 or more:

- **Adults:** \$5
- **Seniors (62+):** \$3
- **Students (6 TO 17):** \$3
- **Bus drivers and/or tour guides** (a maximum of two per group): **Free**

Wednesdays are Senior Days ½ off Admission

Discount applies to group and individual admission.

REGISTRATION

Please make your request for a group tour at least three weeks in advance of your requested date(s).

When you return the Group Reservation to the Oklahoma Hall of Fame, either mailed or completed online on our website at OklahomaHoF.com, you will receive confirmation of your receipt within five business days. At that time, your tour will be tentatively scheduled for one of the two dates you provide. You will receive confirmation of your tour via email or phone 14 days prior to your tour.

ARRIVAL

When your group arrives at the Gaylord-Pickens Museum, your group leader should come to the ticket counter (on the north side of the building) to pick up tickets and finalize payment. The leader should present an exact count of group members.

Tickets can be paid for on arrival. Group tickets are non-refundable.

BUS LOADING/UNLOADING

Buses and motor coaches may load/unload passengers on the north side of the building at the main entrance but must part at the north end of the parking lot in the designated bus parking area.

MUSEUM ETIQUETTE

Photography, video or tape recording in the exhibits is only allowed with special permission from the Oklahoma Hall of Fame administrative staff. Please silence cell phones to refrain from disturbing other guests' museum experience.

FOOD AND BEVERAGES

Outside food and drink (with the exception of sack lunches brought in by student groups) are prohibited.

DIRECTIONS & PARKING

The Gaylord-Pickens Museum, home of the Oklahoma Hall of Fame is located at 1400 Classen Drive (the NW corner of NW 13th Street and Shartel Avenue) near downtown Oklahoma City. Parking is available in the parking lot on the north side of the building. The parking lot can be entered from Classen Drive or Shartel Avenue
